## Out of School Care

To register for the 2025/26 school year please fill out the registration form on the website and email to [oscstrawberryvale@gmail.com](mailto:oscstrawberryvale@gmail.com)

Kindergarten registration for the 2025/26 school year is Feb 1<sup>st</sup> 2025. Registration for the 2025/26 school year for children in grades 1- 5 will open on May 1<sup>st</sup> 2025.

The administration team will contact you via email to finalize registration or provide a space on the waitlist. Each year you must re-apply for a childcare space even if you are on the previous year's waitlist.

Upon acceptance to the program, there is a \$100 registration fee per child that can be paid by cheque to: Richmond Out of School Care Society or e-transferred to the following email address:

**Please note:** Your child or children must be registered students at Strawberry Vale Elementary school prior to signing up for Strawberry Vale Out of School Care.

### \*\*\*\*Supported Child Care\*\*\*\*

CVCC is an inclusive learning environment, and welcomes all children and families into our program. If your child requires extra physical, developmental, emotional, behavioral, or dietary support, please contact the Director to discuss prior to attending the Program. The Director will consider each case separately to ensure the Program can safely care for the child and their needs with the other children enrolled in the program at the same time. If a space is available for your child, a care plan will be required and agreed to by the parents of the child and staff. Care plans will need to be re-evaluated every year.

If your child requires an Inclusion Support worker, it is the sole responsibility of the parents to arrange a contract with Supported Child Development through Island Health (Queen Alexandra Centre for Children's Health). This process must be in place a minimum of one month prior to the child's enrollment in the program. To ensure a successful transition into the Program, the support staff will need to be trained and hired before the child can attend the program. Unfortunately, there may be times where the program can't accommodate extra care outside of currently registered OSC (i.e. early dismissals, Pro D Day, Winter and Spring Break, and Summer camp). Extra care will be assessed case-by-case due to the child's needs, support worker availability, funding from Island Health and first-come-first-served registration.
